FULL	\$100	Special Requirement: Member of lower grade for 1 year OR has been a member of another Live Steam group OR has an operating locomotive. (1) Has full operating privileges for own locomotive. (2) Is a voting member. (3) Is eligible for Director after one year of membership in any grade. (4) Has full access to all Society facilities.
ASSOCIATE	\$40	Typical Member Grade. (1) Can be an operations assistant. (2) Has limited access to Society facilities.
AFFILIATE	\$25	Member of another Live Steam group (Identify on pg 2). (1) Has operating privileges for own locomotive 2 Run Days per member year. (2) Can be an operations assistant or an "Interested Observer". (3) Has restricted use of Society facilities.
JUNIOR	\$15	For ages under 18 years. May observe and/or assist per Safety Rules.

- NOTES: (a) New members pay annual dues amount upon joining. Renewal dues are payable on July 1st of each year.
 (b) New member dues are pro-rated on the first renewal on a quarterly basis when less than a full first year.
 (c) When upgrading membership during a year, pay the difference between the two grades.
 (d) An 'operations assistant' performs Run Day duties, including operation of non-owned locomotive.
 (e) Attendance at annual Safety Meeting is required for any member who works on a Public or Member Run Day
 (f) All members receive all publications.
